RATE SCHEDULE RPP  
Residential Pre-Pay Service

APPLICABILITY

This schedule is applicable for year-round single-phase residential consumers receiving service under the Cooperative's Pre-Pay Service Program. Service under this schedule is subject to the Cooperative's established rules and regulations.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Service under this schedule shall be single-phase, 60 hertz, 200 amps or less, at available secondary voltages.

MONTHLY RATE

Basic Facilities Charge: \$ 1.12 per day

Energy Charges:

All kWhs per month 12.49¢ per kWh

MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE

The monthly minimum bill shall be the Basic Facilities Charge.

MINIMUM ANNUAL CHARGE

Service under this schedule is intended for consumers requiring service on a year-round basis. In no event shall the minimum annual charge be less than twelve times the applicable Basic Facilities Charge.

Consumers requesting Service to be reconnected, which has been disconnected for less than twelve months, shall be responsible for the greater of:

1. The monthly minimum, as determined above, times the number of months the service was disconnected; or
2. The Cooperative's current reconnection charge.

WHOLESALE POWER COST ADJUSTMENT CHARGE

The above kWh charges may be increased or decreased by 0.001 cents per kWh, or major fraction thereof, adjusted for line losses and North Carolina gross receipts taxes, by which the Cooperative's cost of purchased power, on a per kWh basis, exceeds or is less than the Cooperative's base cost of power, as prescribed in the Wholesale Power Cost Adjustment Rider.

REPS AND EE ADJUSTMENTS

The consumer's monthly bill shall also include the Renewable Energy Portfolio Standard (REPS) and Energy Efficiency (EE) adjustments based upon the revenue classification of the account. The revenue classifications and monthly charges are shown in the Cooperative's Renewable Energy Portfolio Standard and Energy Efficiency Riders.

TAXES

North Carolina Sales Tax will be added to the rate and shown on the bill.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

Consumers receiving service under the Cooperative's Pre-Pay Service Program purchase electricity prior to using it. When the consumer's account runs low the Cooperative will alert the consumer by one of the methods outlined in the Program description available at the Cooperative. If the funds run out the consumer's electrical service will be automatically disconnected. The consumer must then purchase power by one of the prescribed methods in order for the power to be restored. Service may be suspended in accordance with the Cooperative's established Service Rules and Regulations.
